This appropriation is intended to cover expenditure incurred by:

- The Agency in fulfilling its mandate to coordinate the inspection arrangements applicable to the common fisheries policy according to the provisions adopted by the North West Atlantic Organisation. Activities concerned include chartering of a vessel upon request of member states interested and according to an ad hoc agreement.
- Subject to agreement between Norway and the Community, the Agency being requested to coordinate the implementation of a pilot project which may include the presence of observers on board of vessels fishing for mackerel.

The expenditure concerned is considered to be operating expenditure and covers all measures related to the mandate, including management.
