2. General objective

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2023/2376 of 22 September 2023 amending Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986 establishing specific control and inspection programmes for certain fisheries; and Regulation (EU) 2019/472 of the European Parliament and of the Council, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels (FV) at sea and in ports of landing.

3. Summary

This report is covering the joint campaign activities in the WW JDP operational area for demersal species and for pelagic species. The report provides statistical information registered by the European Fisheries Control Agency (EFCA) concerning the joint control activities that were carried out by air, sea and shore-based assets and teams of the participating Member States (MS) from the WW JDP.

The numbers presented in this report have been extracted from the EFCA database according to the activity submitted by the MS within the context of the WW JDP. Only those data that meet certain quality criteria are recorded in the EFCA database. These data are provisional and are kept under continuous review. The extraction of data was done on 2nd November 2023, for the WW related events, patrols, and targets.

a) Inspections ashore

During this reporting period there were 2591 inspections carried out ashore, including 21 transport inspections to trucks and 4 to businesses premises. The inspection teams reported in total 171 suspected infringements related to fishing vessels and 1 to a truck. No suspected infringements were detected during businesses inspections.

b) Inspections at sea

During the reporting period there were 483 inspections carried out at sea with 71 suspected infringements reported.

c) Aircraft surveillance

In total, MS reported 583 air sightings with 3 suspected infringements detected during the surveillance flights carried out in this period.
