2. General objective

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986 and Regulation (EU) 2018/973 of the European Parliament and of the Council, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels (FV) at sea and in ports of landing.

3. Summary

This report is covering the joint campaign activities in the North Sea (NS) Joint Deployment Plan (JDP) operational area for demersal and pelagic species. The report provides overall summary information concerning the joint control activities carried out by air, sea and shore-based assets and inspection teams of the participating Member States (MS) from 1st of January until 31st of December 2021.

a) Inspections ashore

There were 1 890 inspections carried out ashore during this Joint Campaign reporting period, with a total of 121 suspected infringements detected on 117 vessels.

In total 50 909 068 kg of JDP species were controlled at landings, a further 1 239 022 kg of non JDP species were included in those catches.

b) Inspections at sea

There were 381 inspections carried out at sea during the reporting period, with 37 suspected infringements reported on 31 fishing vessels. The MS inspectors monitored at sea a total of 806 510 kg of JDP species, a further 311 667 kg of non JDP species were also inspected.

c) Air surveillance

During the reporting period there were 1 627 sea sightings and a further 892 sightings reported by aircraft. Air sightings resulted in the detection of 3 suspected infringements.
