2. General objective

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986 and Regulation (EU) 2019/472 of the European Parliament and of the Council, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels (FV) at sea and in ports of landing.

3. Summary

This report is covering the joint campaign activities in the Baltic Sea (BS) Joint Deployment Plan (JDP) operational area for demersal and pelagic species. The report provides overall summary information concerning the joint control activities carried out by air, sea and shore-based assets and inspection teams of the participating Member States (MS) from 1st of January until 31st of December

2022. This report also includes an analysis of the implementation of specific actions (SA) agreed for this period.

The information presented has been extracted from the EFCA database according to the data submitted by the MS within the context of the BS JDP. Only those data that met certain quality criteria were recorded in the EFCA database. The extraction of data was done on 8th of February 2023 and concerns the BS related inspections and sightings, patrols, and targets.

The outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic and resulting sanitary measures continued to impact on control and surveillance activities by MS until end of the first half of 2022. In 2022, inspection activities resumed but with differing levels of engagement depending on national sanitary protocols. In practical terms, this means that for example at sea some MS restrict their activity to checking fishing gear for compliance with technical measures on open decked vessels, while other MS might carry out gear checks but also carried out last haul assessments. In all cases, the sanitary risks were assessed before inspecting. Similar measures applied ashore with distancing and spatial awareness taken into consideration prior to inspecting.

a) Inspections ashore

During this reporting period there were 2 769 inspections conducted ashore, including 17 transport inspections to trucks, 27 inspections ashore on fishing gear and 23 inspections of premises of enterprises. The inspection teams reported in total 76 suspected infringements, no suspected infringements detected during transport.

b) Inspections at sea

During the reporting period there were 817 inspections carried out at sea including 195 inspections of fishing gear with 29 suspected infringement reported.

During the reporting period there were 605 sea sightings. As a consequence of the sea sightings 1 suspected infringement was detected.

c) Aircraft surveillance

In total, MS reported 384 air sightings with no suspected infringements detected during the surveillance flights carried out in this period.
