### 1. **Background**

This report is a statistical summary of the joint control operations that were carried out from the 2<sup>nd</sup> of January until the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2017 in the operational area of the North Sea joint campaign.

### 2. **Objectives**

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/328/EU, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2438 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2440, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

### 3. Summary of activity

During this joint campaign reporting period 10.910 tonnes of cod, plaice and sole were inspected at landing. In total, there were 3837 inspections carried out ashore, including 2691 market inspections, with a total of 64 suspected infringements reported.

#### a) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign reporting period 1225 tonnes of cod, plaice and sole were inspected at sea. In total, there were 646 inspections carried out at sea with 76 suspected infringements reported on 72 fishing vessels.
