2. **General objective**

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/305/EU, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1396/2014 and Regulation (EU) 2016/1139, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

3. **Summary of activity**

a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign period 3.116 individuals of SAL and 78.000 tonnes of other species were inspected at landing. In total, there were 3651 inspections carried out ashore with 95 suspected infringements reported on 95 fishing vessels.

b) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign period 1.138 individuals of SAL and 10.106 tonnes of other species were monitored at sea. In total, there were 983 inspections carried out at sea with 33 suspected infringements detected on 32 fishing vessels.
