1. **Background**

This report is a statistical summary of the joint control operations, focused on the demersal and pelagic fisheries, that were carried out from the 1st of January until the 21st of December 2018 in the operational area of the North Sea.

2. **Objectives**

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/328/EU, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2438 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2440, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

3. **Summary of activity**

a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign reporting period there were 13443 inspections carried out ashore, including 10149 market inspections, with a total of 132 suspected infringements detected.

b) Inspections at sea
