1. Background

This report is a statistical summary of the joint control operations, focused on the demersal and pelagic fisheries, that were carried out from the 1st of January until the 31st of March 2018 in the operational area of the Baltic Sea.

2. General objective

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/305/EU, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1396/2014 and Regulation (EU) 2016/1139, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

3. Summary of activity

a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign period 1048 inspection ashore reported by the MS concerned. The inspection teams detected 23 apparent infringements on 22 fishing vessels.

b) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign period there were 241 inspections at sea reported by the MS concerned. The inspection teams detected 9 apparent infringements on 7 fishing vessels.
