### 1. Background

This report is a statistical summary of the joint control operations, focused on the demersal and pelagic fisheries, that were carried out from the 1<sup>st</sup> of January till the 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2019 in the operational area of the North Sea.

### 2. Objectives

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986, establishing specific control and inspection programmes (SCIP's) for each region including the North Sea, and Regulation (EU) 2018/973 the Multi Annual Plan for the North Sea, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

### 3. Summary of activity

This report covers the joint campaign activities in the North Sea JDP operational area for demersal and pelagic species. The report provides overall summary information concerning the joint control activities that were carried out by air, sea and shore based assets and teams of the participating Member States.

#### a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign reporting period there were 12,749 inspections carried out ashore, including 10,063 market inspections, with a total of 67 suspected infringements detected, on 63 vessels. In total 399,001 tonnes of fish were controlled at landings.

#### b) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign reporting period there were 910 inspections carried out at sea with 58 suspected infringements reported on 53 fishing vessels. The inspection teams at sea monitored a total of 16,459 tonnes of fish.

MS reported in total 127 inspection results of the last observed haul in 2019. The 91% of last haul sampling were carried out in demersal fishery fleet segments where the risk to catch fish below the minimum reference conservation size was considered to be the highest and where the high-grading issue was most likely to occur.

EFCA deployed its FPV for three patrols in January, March and November of 2019 in the NS JDP area. The EFCA FPV was operating in the NS area for 45 sea days with inspectors from 4 MS deployed for an equivalent of 94 man-days.
