1. **Background**

This report is a statistical summary of the joint control operations, focused on the demersal and pelagic fisheries, that were carried out from the 1st of January till the 31st of December 2020 in the operational area of the North Sea.

2. **Objectives**

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986, Regulation (EU) 2018/973 of the European Parliament and Council, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 1395/2014 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2018/2035, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

3. **Summary**

This report is covering the joint campaign activities in the North Sea JDP operational area for fisheries under the scope of the SCIP. The report provides overall summary information concerning the joint control activities that were carried out by air, sea and shore based assets and teams of the participating Member States from 1st of January till 31th of March, 2020.

a) Inspections ashore

During this reporting period there were 1854 inspections carried out ashore, including 1448 market inspections. The inspection teams reported in total 23 suspected infringements detected, 20 ashore and 3 from market inspections.
