2. General objective

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1393/2014, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1394/2014, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 2019/2237 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 2019/2239, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

3. Summary

This report covers the joint campaign activities in the Western Waters JDP operational area for demersal and pelagic species. The report provides statistical information registered in EFCA data base concerning the joint control activities that were carried out by air, sea and shore based assets and teams of the participating Member States (MS) from 1st January to 30th June 2020.

a) Inspections ashore

During this reporting period there were 1659 inspections carried out ashore, including 19 transport inspections and 12 inspection to businesses. The inspection teams reported in total: 195 suspected infringements detected to fishing vessels, 3 infringements detected during truck inspections and 4 detected during businesses inspections.
