2. General objective

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986 and Regulation (EU) 2019/472 of the European Parliament and of the Council, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels (FV) at sea and in ports of landing.

3. Summary

This report is covering the joint campaign activities in the WW JDP operational area for demersal species and for pelagic species. The report provides statistical information registered by the European Fisheries Control Agency (EFCA) concerning the joint control activities that were carried out by air, sea and shore-based assets and teams of the participating Member States (MS) from the WW JDP.

The numbers shown in this report have been extracted from the EFCA database according to the activity submitted by the MS within the context of the WW JDP. Only those data that meet certain quality criteria are recorded in the EFCA database. These data are provisional and are kept under continuous review. The extraction of data was done on 19th May 2023, for the WW related events, patrols, and targets.

a) Inspections ashore

During this reporting period there were 1136 inspections carried out ashore, including 8 transport inspections to trucks. The inspection teams reported in total 68 suspected infringements related to FV. No suspected infringements were detected during transport inspections.

b) Inspections at sea

During the reporting period there were 135 inspections carried out at sea with 18 suspected infringements reported.

c) Aircraft surveillance

In total, MS reported 142 air sightings with 1 suspected infringement detected during the surveillance flights carried out in this period.
