## 2. General objective

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1986, Regulation (EU) 2018/973 of the European Parliament and Council, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1393, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2018/189 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/2014, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

## 3. Summary

This report is covering the joint campaign activities in the NS JDP operational area for demersal species and for pelagic species. The report provides statistical information registered by the European Fisheries Control Agency (EFCA) concerning the joint control activities that were carried out by air, sea and shore-based assets and teams of the participating Member States (MS) from the NS JDP.

The numbers shown in this report have been extracted from the EFCA database according to the activity submitted by the MS within the context of the NS JDP. Only those data that meet certain quality criteria are recorded in the EFCA database. These data are provisional and are kept under continuous review. The extraction of data was done on 18th July 2022, for the NS related events, patrols, and targets.

The COVID-19 measures have minimized the exchange of inspectors and the visits by MS experts to EFCA Coordination Centre (CC) due to special COVID sanitary measures of national authorities.

### a) Inspections ashore

During this reporting period there were 739 inspections carried out ashore. The inspection teams reported in total 42 suspected infringements.

b) Inspections at sea

During the reporting period there were 250 inspections carried out at sea with 37 suspected infringements reported.

c) Aircraft surveillance

In total, MS reported 511 air sightings with 2 suspected infringements detected during the surveillance flights carried out in this period.
