WHY AND HOW DO WE PROCESS YOUR DATA?	The European Fisheries Control Agency is committed to respect the right to data protection. As the EFCA collects and further processes personal data with the purpose of sightings of fishing vessels and preparing training and communication material with anonymised data, it is subject to Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 ¹ .

LEGAL GROUND/S	This activity is carried out by the Agency based on public interest under Regulation (EU) 2019/473 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 March 2019 on the European Fisheries Control Agency: Article 10 (2) Implementation of specific control and inspection programmes Article 8 (1) (b) European cooperation on coast guard functions
WHAT DATA WE COLLECT?	Video images of fishing vessels and fishing operators on board.
WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR DATA?	Designated EFCA Staff, Contractors (Nordic Unmanned, Lavinia Next), EU Institutions and Bodies (EMSA), Member States Fisheries Authorities.
HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	A number of technical and organisational measures have been put in place by the Agency. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access according to the EFCA Information Security Policy . Organisational measures include restricting access to the personal data solely to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of this processing operation. For the potential use for training or communication material, personal data will go through anonymisation.
HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA?	Maximum of 2 years
YOUR RIGHTS AS DATA SUBJECT	You have the right to access all your personal data, including the supporting documents, and may request them to be updated and rectified, blocked or erased. Further information is available at the EFCA website (see page on Data Protection).
