WHY AND HOW DO WE PROCESS YOUR DATA?	The European Fisheries Control Agency is committed to respect the right to data protection. WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR DATA?	The following staff members: Rafael Duarte as Head of Sector EU Coast Guard, and Vincent Chapel as EFCA senior coordinator/specialist Coast Guard and Staff in DG DIGIT for running the survey via EU Survey IT tool.
HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	A number of technical and organisational measures have been put in place by the Agency. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access according to the <a href="#">EFCA Information Security Policy</a> . Organisational measures include restricting access to the personal data solely to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of this processing operation.
