# 2. General objective

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/305/EU, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1396/2014 and Regulation (EU) 2016/1139, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

# 3. Summary of activity

## a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign period 935 individuals of SAL and 1.247 tonnes of COD, 17.280t HER and 30.957t SPR were inspected at landing. In total, there were 1212 inspections carried out ashore with 51 suspected infringements reported.

# b) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign period 22 individuals of SAL and 317 tonnes of COD, 1.187t HER and 3.098t SPR species were monitored at sea. In total, there were 293 inspections carried out at sea with 13 suspected infringements reported.
