# 2. Background

This report is a statistical summary of the joint control operations that were carried out in the framework of the Baltic Sea joint campaign, in the period as from the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 2016 until the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2016.

## 3. Objectives

To ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/305/EU, in particular the monitoring of compliance with:

- a) fishing opportunities management and specific associated conditions,
- b) reporting obligation applicable to fishing activities,
- c) high-grading ban and obligation to land all catches subject to quota.

# 4. Summary of activity

#### a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign period 2834 individuals of SAL and 21.045 tonnes of COD, HER and SPR were inspected at landing. In total, there were 2396 inspections carried out at landing with a total of 56 suspected infringements reported.

# b) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign period 342 individuals of SAL and 4.088 tonnes of COD, HER and SPR species were monitored at sea. In total, there were 969 inspections carried out at sea with a total of 46 suspected infringements reported.
