

## NAFO/NEAFC JOINT DEPLOYMENT PLAN 2022

### NAFO 4th Campaign

<p><b><u>PARTICIPANTS</u></b></p> <p>1 EST inspector          2 PRT inspectors          1 EFCA Coordinator</p>	
<p><b><u>PERIOD:</u></b></p> <p>27th September – 7th October 2022</p>	<p><b><u>AREA:</u></b></p> <p>NAFO Regulatory Area (NAFO RA), on board the EU (PRT) FPV SETÚBAL</p>
<p><b><u>OBJECTIVE</u></b></p> <p>Monitor compliance with the NAFO CEM and the relevant EU legislation by the vessels operating in the NAFO Regulatory Area, including other Contracting Parties' vessels.</p>	
<p><b><u>RESULTS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6 inspections;</li> <li>• 9 sightings;</li> <li>• 1 apparent serious infringement. Master of the fishing vessel was not fulfilling his duty upon request of the inspector to render such assistance as the inspector reasonably requires to ascertain that actual stowage of catch conforms with the stowage plan, as provided in NAFO Conservation and Enforcement Measures (NCEM) 2022 Chapter VI Article 35.1.(g).</li> </ul>	
<p><b><u>OBSERVATIONS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• FPV SETÚBAL left St. John's (Newfoundland, Canada) on 26th September and entered the NAFO RA on 27<sup>th</sup> September.</li> <li>• During the sea campaign, the number of the EU fishing vessels (ESP, EST, PRT) operating in the NAFO RA ranged from 10 to 12. The number of fishing vessels from other Contracting Parties (CAN, RUS) ranged from 0 to 3. The overall number of</li> </ul>	

vessels fishing in the area during this mission varied from 10 to 14 depending on calendar day.

- Fishing vessels were active in all 4 main Divisions (3LMNO) targeting RED, GHL, SKA and HKS.
- Sea campaign was executed in tail of the Bank where the weather conditions were very good and allowed to make boardings in safe conditions.
- CAN was patrolling in the area with FPV LEONARD J COWLEY. Regular exchange of information with CAN authorities ensured good cooperation and efficient use of the patrol means deployed in the area.
- FPV SETÚBAL completed the sea campaign on 07th October and headed back to Portugal.
